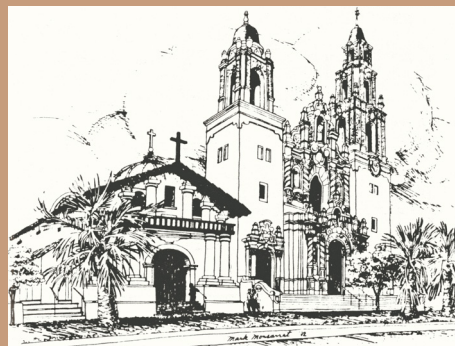

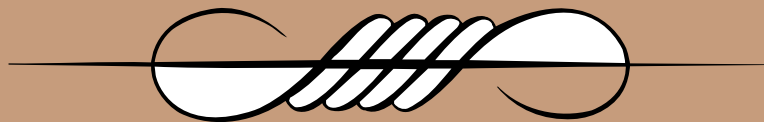

ARTIST BIO

CHASE OLSON, 17, is currently a senior at Terra Linda High School in San Rafael, California. He began studying organ with Dr. Angela Kraft Cross on his 13th birthday, with whom he still studies. He has performed as an organist in the Junior Bach Festival headquartered in Berkeley for three years, and has been the Organ Scholar at the Congregational Church of San Mateo since 2019. He has also substituted in other churches. In 2018, he played concerts at St Dunstan's Episcopal Church in Carmel, St Paul's Episcopal Church in Salinas and St Mary's Cathedral in San Francisco. In June of 2019, Trinity Cathedral of Reno featured Chase playing a concert in their Pipes on the River concert series. He then took lessons with Daryl Robinson and Dr. Isabelle Demers while attending the 2019 POEA in Houston, TX. Chase won a scholarship from the San Francisco Peninsula Organ Academy to travel on a study trip to France in December 2018. He took lessons with Louis Robilliard, Frederic Blanc, Sophie-Veronique Cauchefer-Choplin, Jean-Baptiste Robin, Aude Heurtematte, and Christophe Mantoux, and shared a recital at Notre-Dame d'Auteuil in Paris.

In 2020, Chase was awarded a study scholarship from the SFAGO, and participated in the Vierne-Tournemire Series at St Mary's Cathedral in San Francisco, where he performed Vierne's First Organ Symphony. He also participated in the Oberlin Summer Organ Academy, as well as the Texas Summer Organ Camp put on by Baylor and Rice Universities.

Chase also plays piano, and began studying at age 8. He currently studies with Dr. William Wellborn in San Francisco. He was the recipient of a scholarship award from the Marin Music Chest for piano, and prior to Covid, he played piano every other Friday afternoon for the residents of Nazareth House, a senior care facility, where he loves to volunteer.
